Welcome to our 2010 Camp Season. We are proud to offer you the finest horsemanship program for children in Northern California.

Our summer day camps are a great introduction to riding. Many of our campers return year after year or join our weekly lesson program, which is available year-round. Our program has something to offer for every child whether they enjoy riding as an occasional summer activity or as a competitive sport. We have an excellent staff of instructors and counselors to help your children learn riding and horsemanship in a safe, fun, positive environment. All of our staff members are experienced horsepeople who love what they do.

Our camp program consists of two formats – Full Day and Mini Day. The Full Day camps are open to children ages 7-13. Campers will be divided into groups based on riding experience (see descriptions of levels inside). During the day, the children groom and tack up their ponies, learn stable management and horse care, participate in typical camp activities such as games and arts & crafts, and ride twice. Mini Day camps are open to children ages 6-12. Activities are the same as the full day camp, but in a shorter format with only one riding session per day. All camps include a complimentary photo of your child and their pony in a hand-decorated frame, a memento to cherish for years to come!

NEW RIDERS:

Previous riding experience is not required to attend the European Pony School's Introductory Day Camps. However, if your child is very young or tends to feel timid in new situations we encourage you to schedule a private lesson before the first day of camp. Lessons are offered weekday afternoons and Saturdays, year-round. To schedule, please call 546-7669. **Please note that your child must be at least 6 years old to attend Mini Day Camps and 7 years old to attend Full Day Camps.**

RIDING LEVELS: **Introductory Level** camps are open to riders with little to no experience. **Intermediate** camps are open to riders who have completed at least one Full Day camp at EPS or two Mini Day camps, or participate in the EPS weekly group lesson program. **Advanced** Camps are open to riders who have attended at least three Full Day camps at EPS or who participate in the EPS group lesson program at the Advanced level. The **Mounted Games** camp will be open to all levels. In all camps, riding groups will be divided by experience level. If your child has extensive riding experience at a location other than EPS, please contact us for an evaluation so that she or he may be placed appropriately.

SIZE AND AGE REQUIREMENTS:

Mini Day Camps are open to all children ages 6-12 and Full Day Camps are open to children ages 7-13. Because we use ponies and small horses in our program, we have a rider weight limit of 150 lbs.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS:

We provide all necessary equipment for the horse. Riders are required to wear an ASTM/SEI approved equestrian helmet (bike helmets are not designed to protect the head in case of a fall from a horse). Helmets may be rented from the Pony School for \$10 per camp session. Your child must also wear riding boots with a heel. We have some sizes available to borrow at no charge – however, for large feet (larger than women's size 6) you must provide your own boots.

Up to 10 days prior to camp, switching sessions is permitted only if space is available and your spot can be filled by the waiting list. A fee of \$35 will be charged for switching sessions.
